Rules and Regulations

All racers **must** be **USSS members**,, this should be completed prior to the event. Athletes without a USSS competitors license may want to get the non-scored competitors membership for \$100.00. Do USSS memberships as soon as possible! Racers turning 18 this season will need to complete Safesport and a background check as part of joining USSS, these things can take a while, allow time! If you have issues contact USSS in Park City for assistance.

Coaches- If it is possible to pay for your whole team at one time at registration, it would be appreciated, even if payment is a collection of cash and checks.

This is a USSS event so FIS legal helmets **must** be used for the GS, and all skis must be USSS compliant in order to race. All **coaches must** have a minimum of an **Adult Volunteer USSS membership to be given tickets and allowed on the hill. This membership requires completing Safesport and the Background Check.**

The event will begin with a **Training day** at Bear Peak on Thursday March 5. **Lifts open at 9am.** Racers may be registered from 8am until 4pm, at the Bear Peak Base Lodge. **Coaches should collect money from athletes and register and pay for their teams.**(multiple checks and cash are fine) Team Captain's Meeting will be at 4pm, location is TBD. There will be a WhatsApp for coaches.

Friday's Women's Giant Slalom and Saturday's Men's Giant Slalom, on March 6 and 7, will be held on the Illusion trail. **Coaches will pick up team bibs and tickets at Registration. Non racing athletes will pick up tickets at Registration. The Bib will be your number for the duration of the event. Race Start Time is 9:30am.** Following the conclusion of the races, race awards will be presented in the **Bear Peak Base Lodge Fire Pit area.**

Sunday's Men's and Womens's Slalom race, on March 8, will be on the Illusion trail. Tickets will be issued to athletes and coaches at the Bear Peak Base Lodge, beginning at 7:30am. Athletes will have bibs from their GS race. **Race Start Time is 9:30am.. All bibs must be returned to registration at the end of an athlete's last race run of the slalom, these are NOT souvenir bibs.** Following the conclusion of the race, race awards and overall **awards** will be presented at the **Bear Peak Base Lodge Fire Pit area.**

At the end of Sunday's race, B-Netting work may need to be done. It is expected that all athletes and coaches will assist with this, and awards will take place after all needed netting work has been completed.

Entry Fee & Tickets

The entry fee for the three day event is \$285 per racer, this **includes 3 days of lift tickets (Fri, Sat, and Sun)**, and a commemorative T-shirt. The Training Day on Thursday is \$70.

The entry fees for **EPIC pass holders** will be \$135 per racer, \$20 for the Training Day; **these athletes will not be given lift tickets.**

Checks should be payable to MWVST. We are not able to take credit cards

Lift tickets for Extra Coaches, Parents, & Siblings will be available at Guest Services at the Bear Peak Lodge. \$70 for parents and \$55 for Senior and Youth. Inform Guest services you are a family member of a racer and let them know what High School and State they are affiliated with.
